

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

---

## How can I register for this event?

You can register by printing out the registration form and then mailing the form along with payment to *Boys & Girls Club of Langlade County 411 Superior St, Antigo WI 54409*. You can complete the form electronically as well [here](#). You can pay for the race online using a credit card via our secure race website.

## What if I'm not an avid runner?

You don't need to be a runner to participate in this event. This race is not timed so just come prepared to have a good time and get color splashed!

## Is the race timed?

No, this event is not a timed event. We recommend bringing along a stopwatch if you are interested in knowing your finish time.

## Do I have to wear my Bright Futures t-shirt on the day of the race?

No, but we recommend wearing a white shirt so that you can enjoy the full effects of the color.

## Is the color safe?

Yes, the color is safe. The color powder we use is produced right here in the U.S. It is made from food-grade quality cornstarch using an advanced manufacturing process that has been custom-developed for similar races. It is non-toxic, is 100% safe, and also biodegradable. As with any substance, you will want to keep it out of your eyes and lungs. If you are overly sensitive, you may want to wear glasses or goggles for your eyes and use a bandana or dust mask for your mouth.

## How is the color administered?

Youth members and volunteers of the Boys & Girls Club of Langlade County will toss the color at you when you cross each kilometer marker. No, it will not hurt. The color has the consistency of powdered sugar, so imagine being dusted by powdered sugar as you run. We recommend wearing protective eyewear (sun glasses) to prevent color from getting in your eyes.



## What is the age limit?

There is no age limit to our race. The more the merrier.

## What is included with my registration?

Runners will receive a custom Bright Futures race t-shirt (with early registration) and a bag of color.

## Am I guaranteed a t-shirt?

You are guaranteed a t-shirt if you register early. Registration received less than two weeks prior to the event cannot be guaranteed a t-shirt.

## Can I bring my bike?

We'd appreciate it if you left your bike at home.

## Can I run with my dog?

No, unfortunately there are no animals allowed on this run.

## Can I bring my children? Can I run with a stroller?

Of course you can bring your stroller, but be prepared for it to become very colorful. Our last wave will be the crazy legs wave, and that will be the opportunity to bust out the stroller. Anyone over the age of 5 years old will need to register for the event.

## Is there a packet pickup location?

Yes, you can pick up your race packet on 9/22/17: 3:30pm – 5:30 pm In the Clover Room at the Langlade County Fairgrounds or 9/23/17: 7:30 am – 8:30 am at Langlade County Fairgrounds

**Will the color ruin my clothes or running shoes?**

The color does wash out for the most part, but don't plan on wearing your good running shoes or clothes for this event. We recommend washing your clothing immediately for best results.

**How can I preserve the color on my shirt?**

We have heard that you should spray your shirt with vinegar and then iron it before washing it. However, we personally did not have much success with this method.

**How do I get clean after the race?**

While it is possible to brush off a great deal of the color, you might want to bring a change of clothes or a towel to sit on in your car.

**Will there be multiple waves?**

This is dependent on how many participants we have registered.

**Can I bring my camera?**

Certainly, at your own risk. We recommend keeping your personal devices (cameras, phones, etc.) in a plastic bag if you really need to bring them.

**Are there any refunds?**

Unfortunately, there are no refunds.

**Where do the proceeds go?**

All proceeds from this race will benefit the Boys & Girls Club of Langlade County.
